REPAIRS

REPLACEMENT OF SEVERAL PLANKS/TILES IN CASE OF DAMAGE OR BREAKING OF THE TONGUE (SMALL SIDE)

- Mark the laying direction of planks/tiles.

- Unclip at an angle the tile/plank B with a utility knife.



- Complete the unclipping by sliding a screwdriver between both planks/tiles A and B.

- Unclip all planks/tiles to be replaced.

- Clean the subfloor and place a double-sided adhesive tape where the planks/tiles will be replaced.

- Put back the planks/tiles whose small side clipping is not damaged.

- Complete the length with planks/tiles whose damaged clipping has been neatly cut,

or

- Replace the damaged planks/tiles by new ones.

In order to avoid differences in colour tones, we advise you to keep back a stock to replace any damaged planks/tiles in future.

REPLACEMENT OF A SINGLE PLANK/TILE

- Mark the laying direction of planks/tiles.

- Unclip at an angle the tile/plank B with a utility knife (Fig. 1).

- Complete the unclipping by sliding a screwdriver between both planks/tiles.

- Clean the subfloor and place a double-sided adhesive tape.

- Slightly deburr the tongue of the new plank/tile. (Fig.2).

- Interlock the new plank (fig.3) and roll.
